GUIDELINES ON THE USE OF NUS SAFETY & HEALTH AWARD (NUSSHA) PRIZE MONEY

- 1. There is no timeline imposed on departments in utilising the prize money as it is non-lapsable.
- 2. The amount will be credited to the department's account after NUS Safety & Health Award Ceremony in two installments over 2 years:
 - a. 50% by end May, 2017
 - b. 50% by end of May, 2018
- 3. Department should comply with Office of Financial Services (OFS) guidelines on expenditure of funds for departmental activities, e.g. staff welfare activities.
- 4. Departments have the flexibility to utilise the cash award on appropriate activities beneficial in the journey of continuous improvement to promote and sustain a safety and healthy workplace. These would include but not limited to:
 - a. talks, seminars, workshops, etc. on safety and health
 - b. staff gathering such as annual dinners, lunches, family day, games and sports, etc. to promote employees' satisfaction and health
 - c. initiatives that encourage employees' involvement and commitment to improve safety and health standards in the Department
 - d. giving recognition and rewards to excellent safety and health performers
 - e. activities that develop and promote a safety and health culture that is consistent with its values and achievement of departmental safety and health objectives
 - f. upgrading of workspaces and purchasing of new equipment for a safer and healthier workplace
